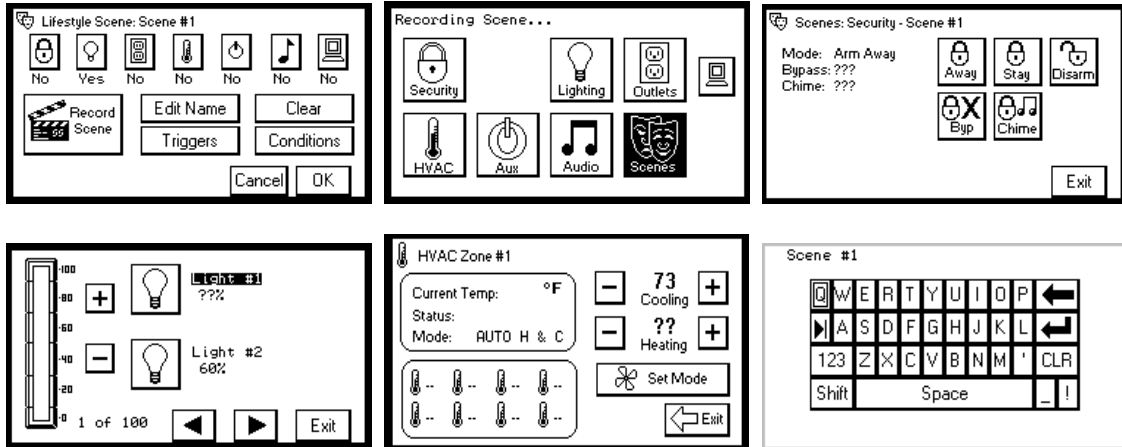


Goodnight

Goodnight is a common scene for users to shut down a home or building for the night prior to going to sleep or leaving. For the purposes of example, some samples are included below:



1. From the Scene Programming Menu, select the Record Scene Icon.
2. In the Scene Recording Menu, select the Security Icon.
3. Select the 'Stay' security status for this scene. After selecting 'Stay', enter a valid access code.
4. In the Scene Recording Menu, select the Lighting Icon.
5. Select each controlled light on the system and assign a dim value of 0%, replacing the '??' value.
6. In the Scene Recording Menu, select the HVAC Icon.
7. Select the Set Mode Icon and choose the Auto Cool & Heat mode.
8. Use the temperature set points for heating an cooling that you desire at night which, generally speaking, is lower than normal but still comfortable.
9. After all the commands are added, return to the Scene Programming Menu by selecting the highlighted Scene Icon on the Scene Recording Menu.
10. Select the 'Edit Name' Icon. Use the Backspace or CLR button to erase the default name and enter 'Goodnight' either using all capitals or selecting the shift key for lower case.
11. Select OK in the Scene Programming Menu.
12. The scene is ready to use!
